

STATUTORY HOLIDAYS – MARINE SERVICES IMPACT

HOLIDAYS ACT 2003

Napier Port will use its best endeavours to offer Marine Services on Statutory Holidays (excluding Christmas Day) if required, subject to the following criteria:

1. The Line or its agent advising in writing to Marine Services Administration, notification that Marine Services will be required not less than 72 hours prior to the intended ETA of vessel.
2. The payment of an additional charge per port call as detailed below:

Arrival or Departure, 2 tugs • Ship's Lines	\$1,248.00

Departure, 1 tug • Shorelines • Bights	\$1,122.00 \$1,122.00
Arrival, 2 tugs • Shorelines • Bights	\$1,474.00 \$1,401.00
Departure, 2 tugs • Shorelines • Bights	\$1,401.00 \$1,401.00

3. Subject to labour availability.
4. Christmas Day – No services will be offered from 0001 hours 25th December to 0600 hours 26th December.
5. The charges as described are subject to change if the Holidays Act 2003 is changed by any further government legislation.
6. Days defined as Statutory Holidays are:

Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Hawke's Bay Anniversary Day, Labour Day, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Day after New Year, Waitangi Day, Easter Friday, Easter Monday
